As one the largest supplier of aviation parts, instruments, and equipment for Russian-built aircraft, Russian Aviation Co. Ltd (RUSAVIA) is keenly interested in aviation history and passionate about the restoration and conservation of historic Warplanes. We are thus proud to support the Warplanes to Siberia (ALSIB 2015) Project.

As discussed, RUSAVIA will purchase two North American T-6 Texan single engine advanced trainers and one Douglas C-47 to fly in formation with BRAVO-369 from Alaska to Siberia in July-August 2015 and take part in the International Aviation and Space Salon (MAKS-2015) in Moscow. I will personally participate in the flights as well as my colleague, an Aeroflot pilot and Air Force veteran. To prepare for this historic flight in 2015, RUSAVIA will organize a test run in 2014 to help plan the route. We will organize all ground logistics at air fields for the Russian leg of the journey.
